

HEBREW WORD SEARCH DEFINITIONS

ALEPH: The first letter of the Hebrew alphabet. At camp, this is the name of the unit of campers going into 3rd and 4th grade.

ARUCHAT BOKER: Breakfast.

ARUCHAT EREV: Dinner.

ARUCHAT TZOHORAYIM: Lunch.

BEIT KNESSET: Jewish place of worship. At camp, this is our outdoor chapel where we have services.

BET: The second letter of the Hebrew alphabet. At camp, this is the name of the unit of campers going into 5th and 6th grade.

BIRKAT HAMAZON: This is the blessing we say after every meal.

CHADAR OCHEL: Dining hall.

CHALUTZIM: Pioneers. At camp, this is the name of the unit of campers going into 2nd grade in Session 1.

CHANICHIM: Campers.

CHOFESH: Freedom. At camp, this is free time for campers to go play and hangout in main camp before the next activity or meal.

CHUGIM: Choices. At camp, these are programming times where campers get to pick what activity they love the most and go participate for extended times.

DALED: The fourth letter of the Hebrew alphabet. At camp, this is the name of the unit of campers going into 9th and 10th grade.

GIMEL: The third letter of the Hebrew alphabet. At camp, this is the name of the unit of campers going into 7th and 8th grade.

HAMOTZI: This is the blessing we say before every meal.

KEHILA KADOSHA: Holy Community. A great to describe Shwayder.

MACHANEH: Camp.

MADRICHIM: Leaders. At camp, this is what we call our counselors.

MENUCHA: Rest. At camp, this is our one hour rest time after lunch each day.

MIR PA'AH: Infirmary. This is where you go to visit our camp nurse.

MISHLACHAT: Delegation. At camp, we are lucky to have several staff members that come from Israel, they are mishlachat.
